The lighting upgrade eliminates the existing fluorescent fixtures and provides new LED fixtures in the Gymnasium. The space was designed using computer-generated photometric layouts allowing for 2x the amount of light with less energy due to high-quality LED products. The project is considered to be maintenance-free for a 5-year period through a professional installation process and the manufacturer's warranties. Nekoosa also received a discount from the project price from a one-time rebate provided by Focus on Energy, Wisconsin utilities' statewide energy efficiency and renewable resource program.
